

New Program Awards Maritime Studies Certificates

For the first time in the 100 year history of the school, The Apprentice School has begun awarding Maritime Studies Certificates to Apprentices after they successfully complete the World Class Shipbuilding Curriculum (WCSC). The first group of Apprentices receiving the certificate consisted of fifty-three Apprentices who were recognized at a ceremony held at The Apprentice School on Tuesday, April 30. Apprentices complete the WCSC when they finish the four, ten-week, terms in the required apprentice academic curriculum which consists of courses in mathematics, physical science, ship construction, communications, business, and safety. Maritime Studies Certificates will be issued four times per year. The Apprentice School is accredited by the Council on Occupational Education to award certificates.
