EXEMPTIONS

*MATH111: If you have taken a college-level math course, such as College Algebra, and passed with a C or better, you may be exempt from this class. Our registrar will have to review your official college transcripts.

*COMM111: If you have taken a college-level English Composition 101 or College Composition 1 course and passed with a C or better, you may be exempt from this class.

Our registrar will have to review your official college transcripts.
